I know Danny and Sarah will give a more thorough update when here in the UK but here is just a quick snap shot of what has been going on:

Adopt a friend, continues to provide essential needs to over 30 families each month. Some of these families still live in extremely poor conditions, mud brick dilapidated buildings, some in just one room.

Community Support, Numerous trips have been made with various people to attend hospital and some of these journeys have taken a round trip of a complete day. The fire engine has also been called on a couple of occasions and Danny has led the way on a number of other rescues (tractors tipping over in the forest, vehicles breaking down)

Recent visitations, As part of a personal development plan, an intern came for a short mission trip and we were also able to host one of our major donors and reacquaint them with the work and the families.

Ukraine, The remaining donations we have received are being forwarded and supplies of food and clothing were being taken from Romania into needy areas in Ukraine. The charity are currently reviewing this area of work as donations have declined considerably.

Church renovation, has taken a considerable amount of time and hard work, below is a quick pictorial summary.







































There is still work to be done on decorating, floor carpeting, replastering and fixing of two rooms and then there is the sound and audio rewiring to be done.
